

Day 1 | Read Exodus 5:1-5 and Acts 1:8, 4:13-20, 9:1-9.

Principle: Men who have encountered God are emboldened to confront unbelievers.

1. Moses acted courageously in confronting Pharaoh. Prior to this though, he tried to get out of this assignment five times. What led to him finding the courage to act?

2. Most men struggle with sharing their faith with unbelievers. What do you think would help you find the courage to share Jesus with unbelievers?

Day 2 | Read Exodus 5:1-9, Daniel 4:30-34, Acts 12:21-24 and Romans 1:18-23.

Principle: Men who do not submit to God are men who want to "be God".

1. What are some of the fundamental reasons Pharaoh would not submit to God?

2. When in your life have you avoided submission or obedience to God?

Day 3 | Read Exodus 5:10-18, Genesis 4:6-8, 1 Samuel 18:12, Mark 11:18 and Acts 14:2.

Principle: Men who do not submit to God will be in conflict with those who do submit to God.

1. Why do people who will *not* submit to God often act in angry or evil ways towards those who *do* follow God?

2. When have you experienced conflict with another person which was caused by a difference in your beliefs?

Day 4 | Read Exodus 5:19-21, Genesis 39:1-20, Matthew 10:5-23, 26:69-75 and Acts 16:16-24.

Principle: Christian men will experience painful setbacks when we try to serve God.

1. Why do you think God allowed the Israelites and Moses to experience these painful setbacks when they were told they would be rescued from bondage in Egypt?

2. What setbacks have you experienced despite trying to walk in step with God's calling for you?
